Haunted Harvest Weekend



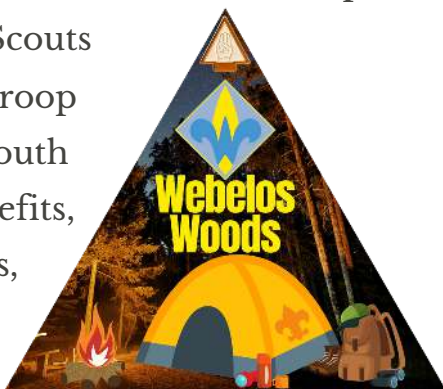

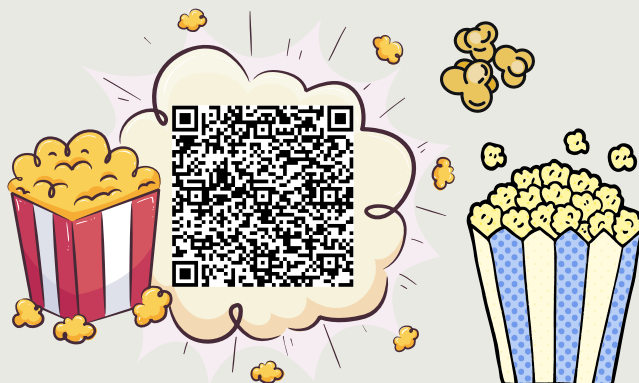

National Annual Membership Fee Changes

National Membership fees are increasing. Youth cost will rise to \$72 plus the \$20 insurance fee, adults will now pay \$45 plus the \$20 insurance fee, and the one-time joining fee of \$25 will still apply to all new youth members. The Crockett Card was created in order to help families spread the cost of Scouting across the year.

Crockett Card Members WILL NOT see a rise in costs related to the membership fees.
