<u>JAMBO '23</u> What Every Family Needs to Know

Your Scout has the opportunity to attend Scouting's largest activity—The National Scout Jamboree which will be held at the Summit Bechtel Reserve in West Virginia. We will be attending from July 19 - July 28, 2023.

The Sequoyah Council Jamboree contingent will depart from Johnson City and travel to the Jambo site in West Virginia to participate in Scouting's version of "The Greatest Show on Earth".

Contingent reservations are on a first-come basis to all who qualify. The Sequoyah Council is sending 4 patrols consisting of 4 adults and 8 youth. After our Patrols are filled, a stand-by list of alternates will be established.

Total cost for this experience is \$1,950. Right now all you need to do to reserve your spot at Jamboree is a completed registration and a deposit. Payment plan options will be sent out in an email following registration.

The jamboree fee includes all transportation, tours, admission fees, meals, lodging patrol and troop equipment, insurance, and training camp before the jamboree. Your expenses will be personal equipment, uniforms, and spending money.

Jambo registration must be completed: **jamboree.scouting.org**.

If you sign up for the jamboree and cannot attend, you will receive a full refund from the Sequoyah Council as long as there is an alternate to take your place.

- Contingent: Each patrol has eight youth and four adult leaders. Only 32 youth spots are available.
- Contingent Fees: \$1,950 which includes all Jamboree fees, travel, meals, and collectibles.

- Requirements: Scout must be First Class & at least 12 years old by the first day of the jamboree, or 11 and have graduated the 6th grade, but have not reached their 18th birthday by the last day of the jamboree. Meet health requirements. Participate in pre-Jamboree training events.
