Of course, you are free to discuss the information with the scout if you so desire, but you are under no obligation to do so.

Your letter of reference will remain secured by the Eagle Board of Review until a decision has been reached concerning the award of Eagle rank, and then your letter will be destroyed.

Thank you for your help. The Eagle award is a high achievement requiring dedication and perseverance. Please share with us your thoughts on this scout.
